While Heavy Construction Environmental project work has been a focus throughout her career, Ms. Destouet is a key team contributor for environmental enabling and construction remediation projects underway within the Houston Airport IAH campus. Her work involves close and frequent coordination with CMARs, their multiple subcontractors and vendors, and environmental remediation contractors in facilitating the removal of expected/anticipated hazards within this 1960s development. TGE and Ms. Destouet have performed more than 140 airport projects across the U.S., with the majority being within Texas and scoped as enabling efforts for renovation, demolition, and new construction.
